President

Treasurer

- Financials Balance sheet on website (numbers on site), \$32K in membership \$2.2K in donations.
- Looks like we have lots of money, but keep in mind equipment for grooming can be expensive if we have any problems
- \$400 to remove graffiti (came out of our money part of the shed agreement with the City)
- Tim is painting door (paint ruined by graffiti removal)
- Suggestion: Spare money into GIC short term -> need a treasurer for this to happen.
- Suggestion: We do need a treasurer but not a VP for societies act, can Keith act in the role?
